Subject: Modified guidelines for Empanelment of Tie-up Hospitals-reg

Sir/Madam

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In reference to Hqrs. Circular of even number dated 05/11/2015, I am hereby directed to convey the approval of Director General in respect of serial no. 4 of the said circular as under:

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Sr.No	Existing	Amended
4.	SMC/DIMS should make the tie up arrangements in such a manner that each ESIC/ESIS Hospital have maximum 5 tie up hospitals attached to it, situated in nearby area such a manner that each discipline of Super Specialty is available in minimum two tie up hospitals. ESIC/ESIH Hospitals should refer cases to these five allocated hospitals only. Any deviation from this system will need HQ approval.	SMC/DIMS should make the tie up arrangements in such a manner that each ESIC/ESIS Hospital should preferably have 5 tie up hospitals attached to it, situated in nearby area such a manner that each discipline of Super Specialty is available in minimum two tie up hospitals. ESIC/ESIH Hospitals should refer cases to the allocated empanelled hospitals only. Deviation (if any) for additional empanelment of more tie-up hospitals (from 5 as described above) shall be decided at the level of the respective Competent Authority ie SSMC/SMC as per the requirements and with due justifications.
